Field Status

The recent weather events has meant Redlands City Council have had to constantly change the status of our field. This has caused some confusion with some members so our committee has sought clarification from the Council and MAAQ.

There are three field status applied by Council;

Status	Impact to RAMS
Open	OK to fly
Use at Own Risk	OK to fly
Closed	Flying not allowed

The Process...

- 1. The determination of the status of the field is made by Redland City Council.
- 2. The determination of whether RAMS Members are able to fly or not is determined by a combination of the status of the field **and** its affiliation with MAAQ **and** therefore subsequent insurance coverage.
- 3. Due to RAMS low impact activity RAMS has received special approval from Redlands Council (attached) to use the field while its status is 'Use at own risk'.
 - 1. The 'Use at own risk' status previously meant RAMS members were not able to fly as insurance would not cover us. Redlands Council Confirmed, via email to the Secretary on 20th December 2020 that RAMS members were allowed to use the field while in the 'Use at own risk' status due to our low impact activity. A similar approval was provided to Ron Cheeseman on the 9th March, 2018.
